Unique Opportunities at UWA

Internship/Practicum Opportunities

McCusker Centre for Citizenship is the first centre of its kind in Australia that places students for services learning opportunities at local organisations which are listed on their website. Arts Practicum: The Arts Practicum is an opportunity to gain work experience while applying the skills you have developed through your degree in a supervised workplace project. Arts Practicum students will have the opportunity to work on a project of real value to the host organisation, which is overseen by a supervisor. This unit is worth six points. Business Practicum: Second or third year business students have the opportunity to undertake a supervised placement within an organisation outside the University. Placements may be advertised in the Business School or be arranged by students themselves. A placement can involve a specific project, where the student

Sports Science and Exercise Health Professional Practice:

This unit comprises a series of lectures, workshops, meetings, personal development plans and mock interviews and an assignment regarding the job application process, issues in employment and the successful transition from student to employee. Bali Art and Culture Studio is a unique cultural program taught over two weeks in January or June/ July in Denpasar, Bali, by a UWA academic.
